# 2014 KENTUCKY ANNUAL PRIVATE DUTY NURSING SERVICES REPORT

## INTRODUCTION

The Office of Health Policy announces the release of the 2014 Kentucky Annual Private Duty Nursing Services Report. The Office of Health Policy is responsible for the private duty nursing utilization collection and reporting set forth in 902 KAR 20:008 and 900 KAR 6:125. This report contains the most recent official private duty nursing data published by the Cabinet for Health and Family Services.

The file received from the Office of Inspector General (OIG), Division of Health Care, contained 10 Private Duty Nursing Agencies. Data in this report covers 100% of all licensed private duty nursing agencies.

Data in this report are organized in three sections. Section I shows beginning census, admissions, discharges and ending census by agency and county of service. Section II shows total patients served by age category, agency and county of service. Section III shows the number of patients served and number of visits for various disciplines (skilled nursing, home health aide, physical therapy, occupational therapy, and speech therapy) for each agency during 2014. The agencies are grouped first by Area Development District (ADD) then by county served. **ADD totals** appear throughout the report following all county data for each ADD. **Statewide totals** appear at the end of each section. In addition, Section IV contains information and changes regarding individual agencies during the year.

### **2014 Private Duty Nursing Services Report Summary**

There were 361 private duty nursing patients served in 2014.

## **Definitions**

**ADD** - Area Development District.

**Admissions** - Number of patients admitted in 2014 (excluding beginning census), as a result of physician referral.

**Total Patients Served** - Beginning Census + Admissions.

**Units of Service: Patients** - the number of contacts a patient received from any type of private duty nursing provider: i.e. RN, LPN, or Nursing Assistant.

**Units of Service:** Units of service provided by RN, LPN, or Nursing Assistant in one hour increments.

The Office of Health Policy produces ten utilization and services reports, which can be obtained by contacting our office. In addition to the Annual Private Duty Nursing Services Report, the following reports are available: Hospital Utilization and Services Report; Long-Term Care Services Report; Hospice Services Report; Magnetic Resonance Imaging Registry Report; the Ambulatory Surgical Services Report, the Megavoltage Radiation Equipment Services Report, the Positron Emission Tomography Services Report and the Home Health Services Report. 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
