



Louisville Metro Community Based Emergency Response Program

The Community Based Response Training has been designed to allow participants experience one of the nations most complete disaster response systems. The goal is to meet the needs of state and local public health organizations and other community based responders. The focus of the course is to equip the students with specific procedures and protocols in emergency response to all types of disasters, natural and man-made.

Louisville's experience has shown that it takes a coordinated multi-agency approach to planning and development, as well as realistic exercises and training to achieve a positive outcome during an actual emergency or disaster. It has been said, "you play on game day the way you practice during the week." As each agency becomes knowledgeable in their area of responsibility, the multi-agency approach begins to develop partnerships as agencies discuss common concerns and develop plausible solutions. No single agency has all of the expertise to successfully handle a major emergency or disaster.
