

## 2010-11 Kentucky AmeriCorps Programs Accomplishments

*Sept. 1, 2010-Aug. 31, 2011*

- **363** AmeriCorps members provided **546,900** hours of service to the Commonwealth and its citizens.
- AmeriCorps members recruited **12,014** community volunteers who provided **74,785** hours of service to their communities. Community volunteers included **1,930** children, **2,379** college students and **2,039** baby boomers.
- Members collected **83.48** tons of food during the Make A Difference Day 2010 Food Drive – enough to feed **33,929** Kentuckians an 8-ounce serving.
- Received **1,749** applications for the **464** available slots.
- Programs retained **82.7%** of their members for the entire service year.
- **556** education awards were issued, not including partial awards.
- AmeriCorps members tutored **6,308** at-risk K-12 students.
- Members provided drug education to **1,793** students.
- Members provided financial literacy education to **1,249** individuals.
- **8,166** homeless individuals and families found or kept permanent or transitional housing thanks to housing counseling and related assistance from AmeriCorps members.
- **26** new homes were constructed, and **62** homes were repaired, rehabilitated or weatherized.
- **3,990** at-risk elderly and disabled received help with everyday living tasks so they could remain in their homes and continue to live independently.
- Members delivered **70,896** meals to at-risk seniors.
- Members provided transportation to **15,958** seniors
- Members assisted **15** youth in attaining their GED.
- Members provided disaster educations to **28,134** individuals.
- Members recruited **108** Community Emergency Response Team volunteers.
- Members helped prepare **5,140** students for college.
- Members provided services to **38,803** clients through local nonprofit organizations.
- Members recruited **1,091** volunteers to provide energy conservation education.
- AmeriCorps members recruited **285** volunteers to develop community gardens.
