APPLICATION FILING DATES

On batching cycle due dates for applications, the CON staff gets numerous requests to review those applications the day they are received. Please allow staff adequate time to process applications before requesting copies. Your patience and cooperation are appreciated.

REQUESTING HEARINGS

When requesting hearings on certificate of need applications, please list unavailable hearing dates on your written request. The Administrative Hearings Branch will make every effort to accommodate you. Staff does not, however, contact parties individually to schedule hearing dates.

REGULATIONS

On January 31, 2006, Governor Fletcher signed new administrative regulations affecting the establishment and expansion of certain health care facilities and services. Specifically, these regulations include the 2006 Update to the 2004-2006 State Health Plan (900 KAR 5:020), the

Certificate of Need Administrative Regulation (900 KAR 6:050), and the Certificate of Need Application Fee Schedule (900 Copies of these items can be obtained at www.chfs.ky.gov/ohp/con.KAR 6:020).

On May 12, 2006, the Division of Certificate of Need filed a statement of consideration as well as an amended after comments version of 900 KAR 6:050 and 900 KAR 5:020. While these amended regulations are being reviewed by the Legislative Research Commission, the companion emergency regulations that were filed on January 31, 2006 will remain in effect.

If you will be participating in a CON hearing, you must provide a list of persons expected to attend the hearing to Koryn Troxell, Administrative Hearings Branch, no later than 2 days prior to the scheduled hearing date. Lists must include attorneys, witnesses, and any other personnel (assistants, observers, etc) planning to attend. On the day of the hearing, all participants must sign in at the Security Desk and will be issued visitor badges. Once all hearing attendees have arrived, the security officer will escort all participants to the hearing room. Any participant to the hearing not on the list must wait to be escorted to the hearing by CON staff.
