The award is given to an individual that embodies the spirit and energy of the late Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., who was a great American Civil Rights leader, religious patriot, and winner of the Nobel Peace prize.

The criteria for nominees includes persons who have demonstrated leadership and achievement to the principles of racial equality, interracial harmony, economic justice, participation in the Martin Luther King, Jr. holiday observances and dedication to Dr. King's dream.

Only one nomination will be accepted per entry to avoid multiple applications. Nomination submission forms should include the name of the nominee, personal contact information, place of employment, and the name of the person making the nomination along with a one-page typed narrative of their qualifications.
