**MEDICARE SAVINGS FACT SHEET**

Medicaid has programs to save some of the cost of your Medicare coverage. Your resources must be below \$6,940 for one person or \$10,410 for a couple. **SSI Dual Eligibles**

If you get Supplemental Security Income (SSI) payments and have income no higher than \$674 for one person or \$1011 for a couple:

- Then, Medicaid gives you full coverage for Medicaid services not already provided by Medicare and pays:  
Your Medicare Part A and B premiums; and  
Your Medicare coinsurances and deductibles.

**QMB (Qualified Medicare Beneficiaries)**

If your income is no higher than \$908 for one person or \$1,226 for a couple:

- Medicaid pays:  
Your Medicare Part A and B premiums; and  
Your Medicare coinsurance and deductibles.

**SLMB (Specified Low-Income Medicare Beneficiaries)**

If your income is no higher than \$1,089 for one person or \$1,471 for a couple:

- Medicaid pays your Medicare Part B premium.

**QI-1 (Qualified Individuals One)**

If your income is no higher than \$1,226 for one person or \$1,655 for a couple:

- Medicaid pays your Medicare Part B premium.

**QDWI (Qualified Disabled Working Individuals)**

If your income is no higher than \$1,815 for one person or \$2,452 for a couple:

- Medicaid pays your Medicare Part A premium (for up to 48 months).
