1. **Total Population:** Based on 7/2003 estimates data taken from the U.S. Census Bureau. <http://www.census.gov/popest/datasets.html> Latest info available as of December 2004.
2. **Percent Below Poverty Level:** <http://www.census.gov/cgi-bin/saipe/saipe.cgi> Based on 2002 estimates from U.S. Census Bureau. Latest info available as of December 2004.
3. **Per Capita Income:** Based on 2002 Census, taken from the University of Kentucky Center for Business and Economics' Research. Roy A. Sigafus (sigafus@pop.uky.edu) Average in 2002 KY PCPI was \$25,494 calculated by dividing the state's total personal income by the state's population. Latest info available as of December 2004.
4. **Percent Unemployed:** Based on December 2004, Kentucky Labor Force estimates. <http://www.workforcekentucky.ky.gov/cgi/dataanalysis/labforceselection.asp?menuchoice=abforce> Only available on county pages.
5. **DES Office Availability:** Based on Department for Employment Services' office locations as of July 1, 1997. There are three types of offices based on levels of services and number of days services are provided. A **full Service** office provides all levels of services. A **Full Time County** office **may** provide only specific services such as Basic ES services and Unemployment Insurance. An **Itinerant** office may be open from 1 to 5 days a week at less than 8 hours per day and provides very limited ES service. (e.g. labor exchange only.) No changes reported as of December 2004.
6. **Child Care Slots:** Based on June 2004, State Certified Family Care Homes in Kentucky Directory. **Licensed and Certified Child Care Slots:** Based on June 2004, State Certified Family Care Homes in Kentucky Directory. Correction made to Certified slots based on capacity listed on <http://chs.state.ky.us/oig/childcare/>
Unregulated Child Care Slots: Based December 2004, data of unregulated child care providers currently available through the KCCMS.
7. **Number Family Resource Youth Service Centers:** Based on December 2004 report provided by OPB. FRYSC Grants based on an annual report from Office of Family Resource and Youth Service Centers. Amount represents total yearly figure.
8. **Number of Public Transportation Providers:** Based on a report by the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet. One small change reported as of December 2003, removed E'Town Transit from Hardin County. No new updates as of December 2004.
9. **All K-TAP Related Data:** Based on December 2004, Information on the KAMES System. **Total Monthly Grant ONLY based on December 2004 PA-264 data plus KC cases on KAMES.** Minority recipients are kids **and** adults. The number of adults are the number of case members that have ID codes or M03, M04, M06 and M12 . There can be members in this total that are under age 18 years of age. The education level of KTAP adults are the members that have ID codes of M03, M04, M06 and M12 but limited to greater than or equal to age 18.
10. **Food stamp Data:** Number of cases, recipients and total Monthly benefits redeemed based on a December 2004 report (HRFSS81).

11. **Number of CHFS Employees:** Based on December 2004 CHFS personnel data. This number is much larger now as it represents staff from the former CFC and staff from the former CHS after the reorganization.
