

MISSION

*The Medical Home Clinic works with children and families to ensure that the child receives high-quality, comprehensive health care.

*The Health Care Providers and families will work as partners to identify and access all the medical and non-medical services needed to help the child and family achieve their maximum potential.



Comprehensive Primary Care Includes:

- Foster Care Intake Physicals
- Well Child Examinations
- School Physicals
- Sports Physicals
- Acute Care/Sick Examinations
- Immunizations
- Referral to Subspecialists (*i.e., Neurology, Orthopedics, Gastroenterology, Cardiology, Pulmonary, etc.*)
- Referral for Treatment/Therapy (*i.e., Speech, Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy, etc.*)
- Dietitian Evaluation and Plan
- Assistance with Community Resources and Services
- Care Coordination

The Medical Home Clinic is staffed by 2 Pediatricians, a Pediatric Nurse Practitioner, a Pediatric Registered Nurse, and a Medical Assistant. A Medical Social Worker, Interpreters, Dietitian, Audiologist, and Speech Pathologist are available on-site.

ELIGIBILITY:

1. Birth-21 years of age

AND

2. Child in Foster Care,
Child in Kinship Care,
Child in Group Home,
or

Child with Special Health Needs

Includes but not exclusive:

**Asthma
Birth Defect(s)
Brain Injury
Cerebral Palsy
Diabetes
Seizures
Spina Bifida**

AND

3. Medical Card (Medicaid/KCHIP)
