**Clinics** in 14 Commission offices and other sites across the state. Clinics use a treatment team to provide care. Clinics offered are:

The **Hemophilia Program** provides on-going care to children and adults with bleeding disorders.

The **Newborn Hearing Screening** Program helps babies get hearing tests before they leave the hospital. Parents learn about choices for follow-up care.

**Youth Transition** helps young people move from school to work, from home to independent living and from child to adult health care.

**Vision Screening** helps children get eye tests before they enter public school.

The Commission also provides **hearing testing and follow-up care, speech, physical and occupational therapies**. Screenings for Scoliosis and hearing are important parts of the CCSHCN program.
