

## **Emergency Procedures**

A critical access hospital shall provide medical emergency procedures as a first response to common life-threatening injuries and acute illness, and shall have available the drugs and biologicals commonly used in life-saving procedures, such as analgesics, local anesthetics, antibiotics, anticonvulsants, antidotes and emetics, serums and toxoids.

Examination services shall be provided by the critical access hospital in accordance with 902 KAR [20:012](#).
