What is the KCCVS?

- A statewide, bi-partisan group comprised of at least 15 members with diverse service and volunteerism backgrounds appointed by the governor.
- The KCCVS actively engages citizens in community service opportunities that enable volunteers, organizations and businesses to share ideas and effectively collaborate to address Kentucky's needs.

Development of the KCCVS

- Established by Executive Order in 1994
- Serves as a conduit for federal funds to support community service and provide leadership for and coordination of volunteer activities throughout the state
- The Cabinet for Health and Family Services provides administrative support and oversight




To promote all Kentuckians working together to meet actual community needs in a way that fosters personal, family and community pride and an enduring ethic of volunteerism and service.


Volunteer Training
