2013 Core Clinical Service Guide (CCSG) Local Health Department Evaluation Results

As part of the 2012 local health department stabilization plan, leadership at the KY Department for Public Health (KDPH) instructed the Nurse Executive Committee (NEC) to begin a quality improvement project to review the Public Health Practice Reference (PHPR) content and revision process. Leadership indicated that *the goal of this review process is to streamline the PHPR document in order to provide clinical guidance for LHD nurses based on core public health services while eliminating any unnecessary program requirements and undue burden on LHD staff*. This report represents the evaluation component of this quality improvement project.



Q1 What is the organization structure for your health department?



Q2 What is your current job position? Please choose the role that you most closely identify with.



Q3 As a nurse supervisor/manager I would prefer that communication related LHD clinical guidance come from...



Q4 Please indicate the amount of your workday routinely spent providing direct clinical services.



Q5 I have a computer that is readily accessible to me during the workday.



Q6 How long have you provided clinical services at a LHD?




Q7 The CANCER SCREENING section contains...


Q8 The EMERGENCIES section contains...


Q9 The FAMILY PLANNING section contains...












Q15 The NEWBORN METABOLIC SCREENING section contains...


Q16 The PEDIATRIC section contains...






Q19 The REPORTABLE DISEASE section contains...






Q22 The VITAL SIGNS section contains...




Q24 Overall, the CCSG contains...


