




2011 Kentucky Asthma Program Fact Sheet- Lincoln Trail District

- The Lincoln Trail District of Kentucky is comprised of 8 counties: Breckinridge, Meade, Grayson, Hardin, Larue, Nelson, Washington, and Marion.
- The 2010 Lincoln Trail District population was roughly 260,000, with about 64,500 being less than 18 (children), and about 195,500 being 18 or older (adults).
- According to the Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance Survey (BRFSS), for 2010, it was estimated that 8,000 children, and 19,000 adults in the Lincoln Trail District currently had asthma.






PREVALENCE

- According to the BRFSS, compared to Kentucky, boys in the Lincoln Trail District reported a higher prevalence of current asthma, while girls in the district reported a slightly lower rate than the state. Adult males in the Lincoln Trail District reported a lower prevalence rate of current asthma, while females reported a higher rate.



HOSPITALIZATIONS

- According to data provided by the Office of Health Policy, between 2000 and 2010, the Lincoln Trail District averaged 6.8 asthma hospitalizations (per 10,000 population) per year, while Kentucky averaged more- at 8.3 asthma hospitalizations (per 10,000 population) per year over the same 11 year period.
- In 2010, among children in this district, there were 17.2 asthma Emergency Department visits per 10,000 population, compared to the state rate of 20.0 per 10,000 population. Among adults in this district, there were 27.2 asthma Emergency Department visits per 10,000 population, compared to the state rate of 29.2 per 10,000 population



MORTALITY

- According to data provided by the Office of Vital Statistics, between 2000 and 2009, the Lincoln Trail District averaged 3.1 deaths from asthma per year. Over this ten year period, the Lincoln Trail District averaged 20.3 asthma deaths per 100,000 adults with asthma, compared to the state average of 17.1 asthma deaths per 100,000 adults with asthma.
