Kentucky's 2010 Make A Difference Day Food Drive yielded **85.61 tons** of food - collected and distributed to local food banks!

The **ATEAM** program won the Kentucky AmeriCorps Program competition and **The Lakes Service Region** won the DCBS Region competition. Three local community organizations participated: The King's Daughters Apartments, the Frankfort Senior Companion Program and the CHFS Weight Watchers Club.

Winning Numbers

ATEAM's 65 members collected 1,506,516 ounces or 47.08 tons. That equates to **23,177 ounces of food per member!** In total, the AmeriCorps programs collected **83.48 tons** of food.

The Lakes Service Region's 408 employees collected 38,401 ounces. That equates to **94 ounces of food per employee!** In total, the regions collected **1.89 tons** of food.

Three local community organizations participated, and they collected **7,734.10 ounces** or 0.24 tons.
