



KASPER Quarterly Threshold Analysis Report 1Q 2015

The Kentucky All Schedule Prescription Electronic Reporting System (KASPER) Quarterly Threshold Analysis Report is produced under a *Prescription Drug Overdose - Boost for State Prevention* grant awarded to the Kentucky Injury Prevention and Research Center by the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. The report provides information on the rates of controlled substance usage in Kentucky by age group and gender based on controlled substance dispensing data reported to KASPER. The analysis includes 1) total Schedule II through V controlled substances; 2) alprazolam; 3) buprenorphine/naloxone; 3) hydrocodone; and 4) oxycodone as well as Schedule II stimulants including amphetamine and methylphenidate.


Schedule II through Schedule V Controlled Substances




Alprazolam




Buprenorphine/Naloxone




Hydrocodone
