Committee Structure

General Committees:

Executive Committee - With the executive director, establishes and implements policies and procedures to ensure effective, cost-efficient organization operations.

Program Committee - Works with independent reviewers and the Corporation for National Service to identify and fund high-quality, innovative initiatives.

Finance Committee - Reviews fiscal procedures to ensure federal and state compliance. Works with staff and fiscal agent to administer state and federal funds.

Standing Committees:

Bylaws Committee - Established policy and develops standards and practices for organization operation and leadership activities. Communicates with the executive director and constituents and annually reviews bylaws.

Governor's Awards Committee - Works with community volunteers to develop and implement the annual nomination process to recognize outstanding community volunteers. Hosts annual statewide awards ceremony.

Nominating Committee - Seeks nominees and selects KCCVS leadership according to KCCVS bylaws. The committee meets year round.

Public Relations Committee - Works with KCCVS staff and constituents to communicate the agency's message and raise awareness of KCCVS programs.

Strategic Planning Committee - Drafts a three-year plan to direct long-term KCCVS activity and progress. Works directly with the executive director to establish goals, objectives and strategies.
