Dear Mr. Kissner:

Thank you for your correspondence dated March 3, 2014 requesting that the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) approve Kentucky's contracts with NTT Data Inc., TEK Systems and Pomeroy IT Solutions, to support scope of work related to operating the Medicaid Electronic Health Records Incentive Program.

- The agreement (number 758-10000004129) is entered into with NTT Data Inc. at a fixed price not to exceed \$2,802,009. The term of the contract is from execution through September 30, 2015.
- The agreement (number 758-100000041410) is entered into with TEK Systems at a fixed price not to exceed \$1,832,682. The term of the contract is from execution through September 30, 2015.
- The agreement (number 758-10000004139) is entered into with Pomeroy IT Solutions at a fixed price not to exceed \$1,449,034. The term of the contract is from execution through September 30, 2015.

CMS previously approved an Implementation Advance Planning Document (IAPD) on April 21, 2014, for \$24,171,534 (Federal share \$21,754,381), an expiration date of September 30, 2015.

CMS completed its review of the contracts and approves them effective on the date of this letter, in accordance with Federal regulations at 42 CFR § 495, subpart D. Authorization of Federal funding for these contracts will be effective as of the date of this letter and will expire September 30, 2015, with total contract expenditures not to exceed \$5,832,074 (Federal share \$5,248,867). Please forward a copy of these signed contracts once they are executed.

Please be advised that subsequent optional year(s) extensions must have CMS' prior approval before exercising this clause in the contracts. As provided by 42 CFR § 495, subpart D, any revisions or amendments to the contracts will require CMS' prior written approval to qualify for FFP.
