



## Medical (MD) Programs

with curricula meeting KRS 214.605, 610, 615, and 620 requirements

The Kentucky Revised Statutes (KRS) 214.605, 610, 615, and 620 mandate HIV/AIDS education for health professionals. All applicants for initial licensure must comply with the statutory requirement for two (2) hours of HIV/AIDS education approved by the Cabinet for Health and Family Services (CHFS) or the Licensing Board or Certifying Entity. Applicants for licensure or certification renewal on active status must comply with this requirement at least one (1) time every ten (10) years thereafter, unless the licensing board or certifying entity specifically requires more frequent completion under administrative regulations promulgated in accordance with KRS Chapter 13A.

The Cabinet for Health and Family Services (CHFS) reviews and approves HIV/AIDS education courses. CHFS does not review courses that applicants have already completed.

CHFS also reviews the HIV/AIDS content of professional schools. If a physician applicant has graduated within five (5) years prior to application from a professional school listed here; their school is listed for the year of graduation; and they have been in a residency program throughout the interim; they shall be deemed to have met the HIV/AIDS requirement and will not have to complete a separate course.
