Old Business Discussion

- EPSDT Prior Authorization update: Anthem will be going to a 6 month authorization, Passport said via e-mail 3 months
- Erin provided us with program codes—see attachment
- Private Duty Medicaid- working with Lee (see attachment) there is now a way to submit to get prior-authorization (being hand done) but the service is up and going and being provided. Pamela (with who?) says they are issuing up to 6 months on the fee for service. Bob says in e-mail says 3 traditionally. On fee for service side, it can be submitted for CareWise. Pam has reviewed the requests they have received. They can be reviewed and a decision sent, but it cannot be issued without the prior-auth. Will check with Lee to see if she can get the fee schedule posted. RN and LPN rates are the same based on the Private Duty Regulation. Sharon requested report from MCO's on how they are going to handle private duty requests.
