KENTUCKY CITATION LISTING

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1. Kentucky revised statutes, Chapter 18, on State Personnel, as amended through February 22, 1972, including the understanding contained in the March 16, 1972, letter from Carl V. Beeler, then Chief, Division of Intergovernmental Personnel Programs, USCSC, to Miss Cattie Lou Miller, Kentucky Commissioner of Personnel, that in the Grant-Aided Agencies the Federal standards must determine which assistant or deputy may be exempted from coverage. Also included is the understanding contained in paragraph 3 of the March 16, 1972, letter that the only effect of Section 3 (1) and Section 4 (1) and (2), of House Bill Number 120, is to remove the Commissioner of Personnel class from Merit System coverage and to revise the method of appointment to authorize direct appointment by the Governor.
 2. Personnel rules of the Kentucky Department of Personnel, as amended through March 9, 1973, including the understanding contained in the October 31, 1961, letter from the Kentucky Commissioner of Personnel to the Regional Merit System Representative that provisional appointments will not be made or continued if there are as many as three (3) available eligibles for a position.
 3. Policy memoranda in effect through November 25, 1970, which were issued by the Commissioner of Personnel to all Department and Agency Heads.
