## Kentucky Health Alert Network (HAN) "A Hole-In-One for the Sentinel Sites"

The HAN is mandated by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) as part of the Federal Public Health Preparedness and Response Bioterrorism grant. It will provide a 24/7 flow of critical health information to federal, state, and local participants.

There are three types of alerts:



High - Public Health Emergency

Medium - Public Health Advisory

Low - Public Health Update
