

Provide quick and compassionate services to persons with opioid use disorder

Connect patients at risk for overdose with low barrier access to compassionate harm reduction and treatment services, including medications for opioid use disorder.

Utilize peer support specialists with lived experience to link patients with treatment services and recovery supports, such as transportation, housing, and recovery supports.

Provide referrals to ongoing services following discharge to continue opioid use disorder treatment as well as co-occurring physical and mental health services.

The Kentucky Opioid Response Effort (KORE) supports 11 Bridge and Consult programs and plans to add 10 more bridge clinics in 2023-24 through a project with the Kentucky Hospital Association.
