

## Race to the Top Training Incentives for Kentucky All STARS Providers

Race to the Top training incentives are now available to early care and education providers who participate in Kentucky All STARS. These programs are eligible to receive up to 150 training clock hours (at no cost to the provider) between July 1<sup>st</sup> and December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2017 to promote and support quality in their program.

This Race to the Top training incentive is available for approved courses that align with standards to support programs to increase quality and advance in Kentucky All STAR levels. Approved courses include those focusing on developmental screening, curriculum, instructional practices, teaching and learning, and family and community engagement.

The four training agencies listed below in partnership with Child Care Aware of Kentucky will coordinate and deliver training statewide through December 31, 2017. Contact the training agency that serves your region to identify training to meet your program's needs.
