Child care providers accepting child care subsidy payments are required to participate in the Kentucky All STARS Program - the state's quality-rating system for all early care and education programs.

### What is Kentucky All STARS?

**Kentucky All STARS** is a quality rating system for all early care and education programs in Kentucky including Licensed Type I, Type II, Certified Family Child Care Homes, Head Start and public preschools. **Kentucky All STARS** recognizes programs that have made a commitment to continuous quality improvement and provides programs with additional support including training, technical assistance and coaching.

**Kentucky All STARS** is based on Kentucky's Early Childhood Standards and research-based indicators of quality.

- Parents can participate in family involvement activities.
- Early Care and Education Programs participating in Kentucky All STARS at Level 3 or above have been verified as high quality.
- Programs participating in Kentucky All STARS have access to quality coaching, training materials, and professional development opportunities to help them maintain a high quality of early childhood care.
