1. 907 KAR 10:015

A. This administrative regulation was filed on August 14, 2024.

B. Summary of Administrative Regulation: this administrative regulation establishes the method for determining amounts payable by the Medicaid program for outpatient hospital services.

B. Summary of Administrative Regulation: this administrative regulation establishes spousal impoverishment and nursing facility requirements for Medicaid eligibility determinations for individuals for whom resources are considered for Medicaid eligibility purposes.
