

The Kentucky Integrated Health Insurance Premium Payment (KI-HIPP) program helps pay the cost of the health insurance that your place of employment offers.

## Good news!

- If you're a single person it can pay your health insurance premium cost or if you're part of a family it can pay your family health insurance premium cost
- It expands your pool of doctors -- you can go to Medicaid doctors and/or to doctors in your insurance plan
- A family can be on the same health insurance plan

## Who can apply:



A single Medicaid person

**or**

a family that has a Medicaid person in the home



*You can apply whether you are already enrolled in your employer's health insurance plan or you are not signed up.*

## What should I do next?

### Step 1.

Get the health insurance plan and a rate sheet from your employer.

Then get a KI-HIPP application on-line at [kihipp.ky.gov](http://kihipp.ky.gov)

### Step 2.

Send the application and information about your health insurance plan to the KI-HIPP office at:

### Step 3.

The KI-HIPP worker will let you know if you can be in this program.

Your next step is to enroll in your employer health insurance plan

### Step 4.

If you are already paying insurance premiums all you need to do is send us a copy of your insurance card and your paystub showing payment

**Step 5. You get back the amount you paid for your health insurance premium!**
