      - *“Can we please work on 90 day supply and medsync short fill overrides for Medicaid (SCC 47/48)? As Medicaid is a large part of my population base and medsync program this affects me greatly. It also may be an answer to reimbursement issues that we are still seeing with our MCOs. [90 day supplies] would increase compliance. It also will tackle the issue of members not having consistent coverage (losing benefits/forgetting appointments etc) as they would still have their medication. I think overall it would promote better health outcomes for all Kentuckians.”*
