

As of 7/19/21, there are 8,621 Medicaid enrollees that are currently incarcerated. The total Medicaid population is approximately 1.5 million.

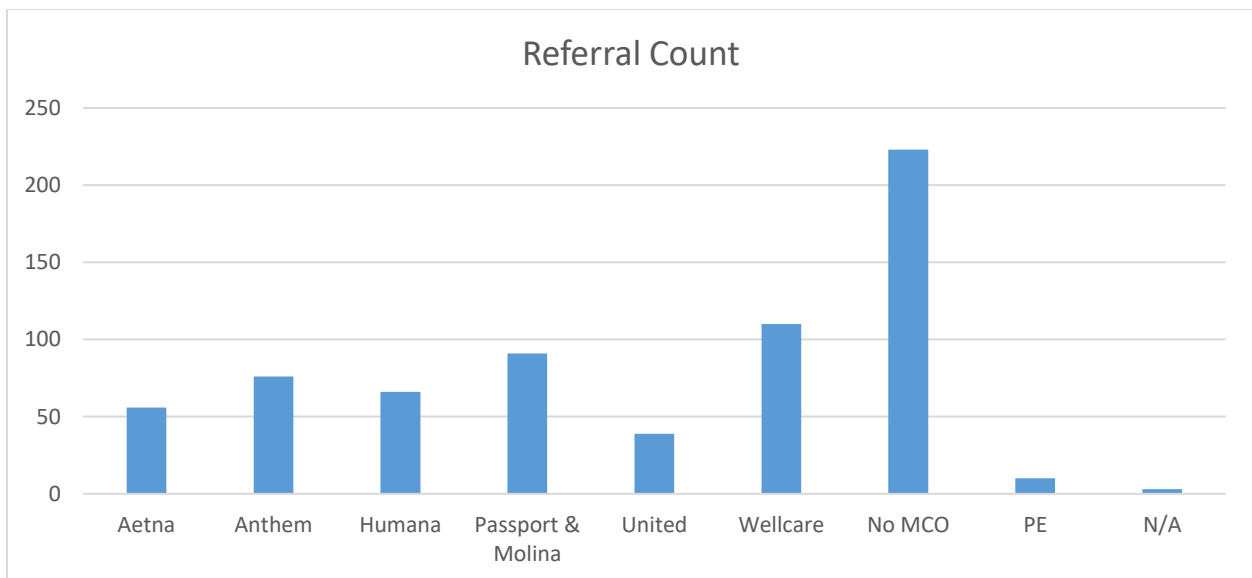
As of 9/9/21, there are 8,776 Medicaid enrollees that are incarcerated.

NGA Reentry Program

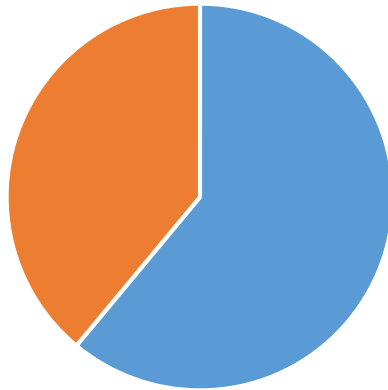
The goal of the Reentry Program is to improve outcomes for people with substance use disorder (SUD) and serious mental illness (SMI) and decrease recidivism in the prison/legal system. The population includes inmates of KSR and KCIW with a projected release date within 6 months and MH Level 2 or higher or SU Code of Medium or higher.

Since 11/15/19, there have been 675 released individuals that qualified for the program.

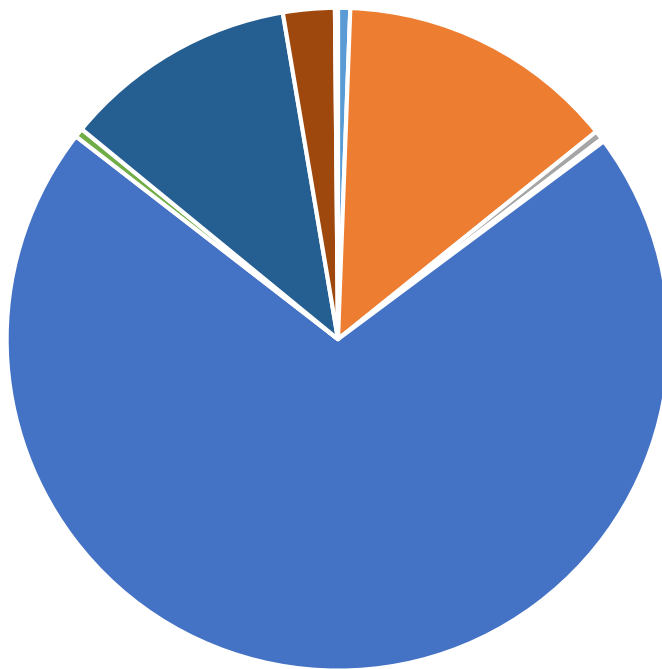
