Breast Cancer Screening (BCS)

SNS – E is a new HEDIS measure for screening individuals for unmet food, housing, and transportation feeds as well as referral to appropriate resource

- Health Plan Strategic Planning assessing overall interventions for gaps and barriers with cross collaborative workgroups
- Actively developing plans to mitigate the barriers and implement interventions to target our members for improved health outcomes related to the targeted measures
- Focused on addressing our members disparities of health and tying back to the VBP measures and our Quality Strategy Measures
- Developing a program from Pregnancy through Adolescence to address the members and support them through their journey for receiving appropriate services and improving health outcomes
- Interventions addressing these measures
 - QPA visits education with providers collaborating with PR and Pharmacy
 - Health Coach calls scheduling appointments with members and providing education on services, valued added services and addressing SDOH needs such as transportation to and from appointments.
 - Member Incentives to encourage compliance and support the member
 - Implementation of services to support SDOH needs related to food insecurities, transportation and housing support
