HARM REDUCTION OUTREACH SERVICES

The Kentucky Department for Public Health (KDPH) Harm Reduction Program partners with Local Health Departments and Community-Based Organizations who serve individuals at risk of overdose. These services are provided throughout Kentucky to better meet the needs of individuals at risk of overdose in a variety of ways.



Mobile Harm Reduction Unit

The KDPH Mobile Harm Reduction Unit provides access to overdose prevention resources for individuals and communities at risk of overdose in a stigma free setting. Services such as free HIV and Hepatitis C testing are also provided to individuals who otherwise might not have access.



Harm Reduction Program Exhibitor

Local Health Departments or Community-Based Organizations can also request the Harm Reduction Program to serve as an exhibitor by tabling at an event with other partners. Tabling at events can be provided indoors or outdoors, depending on the location of the event. Access to electricity is preferred, but not a requirement.



Harm Reduction Program Staff

The KDPH Harm Reduction Program staff are available to promote the FindNaloxoneNowKY.org website, provide overdose education, naloxone distribution, drug testing strips, as well as information on substance use treatment and recovery support services.
