## What You Need to Know:

- Pregnant and recently pregnant patients are more likely to get severely ill with COVID-19.
- COVID-19 vaccination is recommended for all people who are:
  - 1. Pregnant
  - 2. Breastfeeding
  - 3. Trying to get pregnant now
  - 4. Might become pregnant





- The vaccine is safe.
- The vaccine is recommended by <u>CDC</u>,\* <u>ACOG</u>,\* and <u>SMFM</u>\*.
- Getting a COVID-19 vaccine can protect you from severe illness from COVID-19.
- Patients who get infected with COVID-19 during pregnancy are more likely to have a preterm birth and their babies are more likely to have poor outcomes.
