

HPV START @9 Vaccination Toolkit

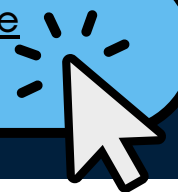
Human Papillomavirus or HPV is a common virus that can lead to many different types of cancer later in life.
