WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Tetanus (lockjaw) is caused by the toxin producing bacterium *Clostridium tetani*. It attacks the nervous system.

Caused by bacteria in soil entering flesh via a wound from contaminated objects.

SYMPTOMS:

- Muscle spasms
- Fever
- Trouble swallowing
- Rapid heart rate
- Incontinence

Immediate treatment with wound cleaning, medication and tetanus antitoxin injection.



- Routine childhood immunization (DTaP)
 2, 4, 6, 12-23 months and 4-6 years
- Adolescent booster (Tdap)
 - o at 11-12 years
- Adult booster (Tdap or Td)
 - every 10 years
- With every pregnancy
