

AFFIDAVIT OF HOMELESS STATUS FOR FEE EXEMPT CERTIFIED RECORD OF BIRTH

PLEASE READ THE INFORMATION AND REQUIRMENTS SECTION BEFORE COMPLETING THIS AFFIDAVIT

Pursuant to **KRS 213.141(d),** no fee or compensation shall be allowed or paid for furnishing a certificate of birth record to a qualified homeless individual, provided the individual has been verified as homeless. This affidavit must be used for the purpose of requesting a fee exempt copy of birth record.

INFORMATION

- A fee exempt certified copy of a birth record may be obtained from the State Registrar for a registrant who was born in Kentucky.
- Each eligible person may only receive one fee exempt birth record, per application.
- ➤ Requests for fee exempt copies are still subject to other requirements outlined in the application for obtaining copies of birth records.
- Applications for a certified copy of a birth record may be obtained by visiting the Office of Vital Statistics website or by selecting and downloading the link provided at https://chfs.ky.gov/agencies/dph/dehp/vsb/Forms/VS37BirthApp.pdf.

AFFIDAVIT OF HOMELESS STATUS FOR FEE EXEMPT CERTIFIED RECORD OF BIRTH

REQUIRMENTS

Requirements for eligibility to receive a fee exempt certified copy of a birth record:

- Any entity or person lawfully entitled to request a certified copy of a birth record on behalf of a homeless person, child, or youth.
- ➤ Per KRS 213.141 (4)(d), A "homeless person" or a "homeless youth" have the same meaning as defined in KRS 198A.700 or 42 U.S.C. sec. 11434a(2).
- A "homeless services provider," as defined by KRS 213.141 (4)(d)(1) (4), who has knowledge of a person's status as homeless, must provide verification through completion of the affidavit.
- > The affidavit will not be considered complete unless completed and signed by the homeless services provider making the request for the certified copy of the birth record.
- Provide a copy of your (the requester's) ID, which is either: an agency-issued photo ID or a state-issued driver license for you, the requester, and a copy of your business card or organization-issued name tag (if it does not include a photo).

HOMELESS SERVICES PROVIDERS

A "homeless services provider" includes:

> Director or designee of a governmental or nonprofit agency.

KRS 213.141 (4) (d) 1 states... "A director or designee of a governmental or nonprofit agency that receives public or private funding to provide services to homeless people;"

➤ Local educational agency liaison.

KRS 213.141 (4) (d) $\overline{2}$ states... "A local educational agency liaison for homeless children and youths designated pursuant to 42 U.S.C. sec. 11432(g)(1)(J)(ii), or a school social worker or school counselor;"

> Director or of a federal TRIO Program, Gaining Early Awareness and Readiness for Undergraduate Program.

KRS 213.141 (4) (d) 3 states... "The director or director's designee of a federal TRIO Program or a Gaining Early Awareness and Readiness for Undergraduate Program; or"

> A financial aid administrator.

KRS 213.141 (4) (d) 4 states... "A financial aid administrator for an institution of higher education."
