

Big Sandy District Determination

The Big Sandy District has improved to score in the **MEETS REQUIREMENTS** category.

A determination of **MEETS REQUIREMENTS** means that the district is in compliance in meeting the state targets. This may include correcting any identified non-compliance within one year of notification to the district. The district is not subject to any enforcement action by the state.

Indicators 1, 7 and 8 are compliance indicators. The target is set by the Office of Special Education Programs (OSEP).

Indicators 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 are performance indicators. These are a measure of the districts overall performance in several key areas. These targets were set during the development of the State Performance Plan (SPP). Indicator 3 results are explained further on page 2.
