AN ACT relating to breastfeeding.


Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

1 SECTION 1, A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 211 IS CREATED TO
2 READ AS FOLLOWS:


3 (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of the law, a mother may breastfeed her
4 baby or express breastmilk in any location, public or private, where the mother is
5 otherwise authorized to be. Breastfeeding a child or expressing breastmilk as part
6 of breastfeeding shall not be considered an act of public indecency and shall not
7 be considered indecent exposure, sexual conduct, lewd touching, or obscenity.

8 (2) A municipality may not enact an ordinance that prohibits or restricts a mother
9 breastfeeding a child or expressing breastmilk in a public or private location
10 where the mother and child are otherwise authorized to be. In a municipal
11 ordinance, indecent exposure, sexual conduct, lewd touching, obscenity, and
12 similar terms do not include the act of a mother breastfeeding a child in a public
13 or private location where the mother and child are otherwise authorized to be.


14 (3) No person shall interfere with a mother breastfeeding her child in any location,
15 public or private, where the mother is otherwise authorized to be.
