LIGHTING REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADE A AND MANUFACTURING DAIRY FARMS

GRADE A

KAR 50:110. Grade A milk and milk products standards

Relates to: KRS 217C.010 to 217C.990

Statutory Authority: KRS 194.050, 211.090

Section 1. (1) Grade A Milk and Milk Products

The permit requirements, sanitary and quality requirements for the production, processing, handling and distribution of Grade A milk and milk products as set forth in the publication entitled, "Grade A Pasteurized Milk Ordinance, 2003 recommendations of the United States Public Health/Food and Drug Administration is hereby adopted without change.

Administrative Procedures:

This item is deemed to be satisfied when:

A minimum of twenty (20) foot-candles of light is provided at all working areas from natural and/or artificial light for milk house operations.

The milking barn is provided with natural and/or artificial light to insure that all surfaces and particularly the working areas will be plainly visible. The equivalent of at least ten (10) foot-candles of light in all working areas shall be provided.

MANUFACTURING

KAR 50:032 Standards for farm requirements for manufacturing grade milk

Relates To: KRS 217.005 to 217.215, 217C.010 to 217C.990

Statutory Authority: KRS 194.050, 211.09

This item is deemed to be satisfied when:

Artificial light shall be provided with a minimum 100 watts capacity. The light fixture shall not be located over the bulk tank. Floodlights are recommended near the ends of the bulk tank.

Work areas shall have a minimum of ten (10) foot candles of light distributed for both day and night milking.
