Does Your Site Qualify?

- Located in a Health Professional Service Area (HPSA)
- Provides services on discounted fee scale
- Accepts Medicare, Medicaid, and KCHIP
- Can document sound fiscal management

NHSC Approved Site

1. Determine if your site is located in a HPSA
2. Develop a Discounted Sliding Fee Scale
3. Complete the Recruitment and Retention Assistance Application every three (3) years
