

Pediatric Covid Vaccine

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Pre-ordering Pediatric Pfizer Vaccines

For the initial rollout of the Pfizer pediatric vaccines, Kentucky has received an allocation of doses. The doses will be available for providers to pre-order via the link below and will ship out in waves. The waves will ship out based on the date of the pre-order submission beginning as soon as the EUA is issued.

Shipment for the pediatric vaccines can begin once the FDA issues the EUA. Vaccine administration can begin once the ACIP and CDC recommendations are issued.

Pre-orders must be submitted by the following times for each wave:

Wave 1: Noon (12:00) eastern on Thursday, October 21st

Wave 2: Noon (12:00) eastern on Friday, October 22nd

Wave 3: Noon (12:00) eastern on Monday, October 25th

The pre-orders are only for the initial rollout of the pediatric doses. Providers will be able to place order requests in KYIR in the following weeks after the initial shipments.

Pre-order are available in minimum quantities of 300 doses for the launch of the pediatric doses. The minimum dose order will decrease to 100 doses in subsequent weeks and be available for ordering in KYIR.

Q: Can the current adult/adolescent formulation (purple cap) be used to vaccinate children 5 to <12 years old once the vaccine is authorized for this age group?

A: No. For children under 12 years of age, you cannot use the current formulation and will need to use the future pediatric (orange cap) formulation.

Purple Cap – Adult/Adolescent: Authorized only for aged 12 years and older



Orange Cap – Pediatric: Future authorization for aged 5- to 12 years. A separate vaccine formulation specific for a 10mcg dose will be introduced.



NOTE: Use of the current adult/adolescent formulation (purple cap) to prepare doses for children 5 to <12 years would result in an injection volume for the 10mcg dose of 0.1mL, which is both generally considered too small for typical IM injections and has not been studied.

*Diluent: 0.9% sterile Sodium Chloride Injection, USP (non-bacteriostatic; DO NOT USE OTHER DILUENTS

**The vaccine is currently under emergency use authorization review by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) for children 5 to <12 years old
