- Part I convened January 8th
- Part II convened February 5th
 - February 8th – Last day for Bill Requests
 - February 15th – Last day for new Senate bills
 - February 19th – Last day for new House bills

2019 Legislative Session Recap

- March 12th and 13th were Concurrence days
- March 14th – 25th were Governor veto days
- March 29th – Session ended
