HIV Cluster, Huntington, WV January 1, 2018 - Current

- ▶ 2013-2017 Cabell County HIV Case Average - 8
 - ▶ Average annual IDU associated cases - 2
- ▶ Cluster case count as of October 30, 2019 - 81
 - ▶ 18 cases identified in 2018 - 8 in the 4th Quarter
 - ▶ 63 cases identified in 2019
 - ▶ 16 in the 1st Quarter
 - ▶ 30 in the 2nd Quarter
 - ▶ 17 in the 3rd Quarter
 - ▶ 0 in October



Ending the HIV Epidemic (ETE)

HHS will work with each community to establish local teams on the ground to tailor and implement strategies to:



Diagnose all people with HIV as early as possible.

Treat the infection rapidly and effectively to achieve sustained viral suppression.



Prevent new HIV transmissions by using proven interventions, including pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP) and syringe services programs (SSPs).

Respond quickly to potential HIV outbreaks to get needed prevention and treatment services to people who need them.
