Serve Kentucky manages AmeriCorps programs across the entire Commonwealth of Kentucky. 696 AmeriCorps members served 670,641 hours and earned \$2,562,242 in education awards. AmeriCorps members recruited 4,213 volunteers who provided 155,955 hours of volunteer service (valued at \$4,959,369). AmeriCorps members served 74,078 students and provided food support services to 3,344 students. Serve Kentucky also provided housing services to 465 individuals and collected 153,345 pounds of food for individuals facing food insecurity.

AmeriCorps has 2 members in Meade County.

Kentucky Transitional Assistance Program (KTAP)

Your county received \$247,028 in KTAP issuance. This has been allocated to 70 households in the past fiscal year.

During fiscal year 2024, in Meade county there were 14 people enrolled in Quit Now Kentucky (no-cost tobacco quitline), QUIT Now Kentucky provided 3,947 coaching sessions across the Commonwealth.

Division of Family Resource and Youth Services Centers (FRYSC)

Meade County received \$417,911 in funding for 1 school district(s). The total student enrollment for schools served by FRYSC was 4,988, and 48% of these students were eligible for free or reduced school lunch. Donations and volunteer time totaled \$152,054.

Additional grants totaled \$2,300.

Meade County received \$612,238 from the Child Care Assistance Program issuance, supporting up to 181 providers a year.

The Division of Child Support Enforcement served 925 children, collecting \$2,157,302 in current and past due child support, during fiscal year 2024. The agency established 816 orders.

There were 38 children cared for by foster families, 36 of whom received a combined per-diem totaling \$3,162.

47% of children in foster care had a goal of adoption. 52% had a goal other than adoption (e.g. reunification).

According to KASPER data, 8,220 unique patients residing in your county received a pharmaceutical controlled substance. Opioid analgesics accounted for 22,968 of the 54,174 total controlled prescriptions dispensed.
