## Division of Family Resource and Youth Services Centers (FRYSC)

Metcalfe County received \$190,827 in funding for 1 school district(s). The total student enrollment for schools served by FRYSC was 1,447, and 68% of these students were eligible for free or reduced school lunch. Donations and volunteer time totaled \$45,812. Additional grants totaled \$750.

Metcalfe County received \$95,414 from the Child Care Assistance Program issuance, supporting up to 28 providers a year. The Division of Child Support Enforcement served 515 children, collecting \$760,513 in current and past due child support, during fiscal year 2024. The agency established 480 orders.

There were 19 children cared for by foster families, 14 of whom received a combined per-diem totaling \$1,707.

36% of children in foster care had a goal of adoption. 63% had a goal other than adoption (e.g. reunification).
