


Robertson County - Fiscal Year 2024

Division of Family Resource and Youth Services Centers (FRYSC)

Robertson County received \$62,548 in funding for 1 school district(s). The total student enrollment for schools served by FRYSC was 454, and 74% of these students were eligible for free or reduced school lunch. Donations and volunteer time totaled \$1,000. Additional grants totaled \$1,000.

Robertson County received \$26,584 from the Child Care Assistance Program issuance, supporting up to 8 providers a year. The Division of Child Support Enforcement served 72 children, collecting \$87,778 in current and past due child support, during fiscal year 2024. The agency established 65 orders.

There were 0 children cared for by foster families, 0 of whom received a combined per-diem totaling \$0.

0% of children in foster care had a goal of adoption. 0% had a goal other than adoption (e.g. reunification).
