What is KI-HIPP?



The **Kentucky Integrated Health Insurance Premium Payment (KI-HIPP)** program is a voluntary Medicaid program offered to Medicaid members to help pay for the cost of an Employer-Sponsored Insurance (ESI) plan. In addition, enrolled members may also include Non-Medicaid policy holders with at least one Medicaid member on their plan.

How can KI-HIPP benefit me?



May widen healthcare network by providing access to doctors through the full traditional Medicaid network



May help make employer health insurance affordable by reimbursing the policy holder for the monthly premium



May allow an entire family to be on the same health insurance plan and access the same doctors

Am I eligible for KI-HIPP?

Eligibility for the KI-HIPP program is based on the following criteria:



Medicaid Member on the Policy



Access to Employer Health Insurance



Potentially Eligible for KI-HIPP

Insurance through an **Employer (ESI) Plan**



- United Mine Workers
- Retiree Health Plan
- COBRA
