

Data Collection Process

- Standardized methodology for collection and analysis
- All states use core questionnaire
- Allows for state-to-state comparisons
- Allows for local-to-local comparisons (SMART BRFSS)





Mode of Data Collection


- Landline Phone (Done since 1985)
- Cell Phone (Started in 2009)
- Mail Survey to Non-Respondents (in pilot phase)
- Web-based Survey to Non-Respondents (in pilot phase)
- Face-to-Face interviewing (Piloted only in Kentucky)

- 3. Rest of Louisville



Kentucky County Hispanic Populations


